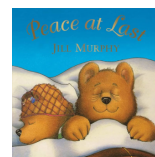
Your child will need to bring their book bag, water bottle and ,soon, their reading book and reading record with them to school everyday. **Please remember to label all of your child's uniform.**

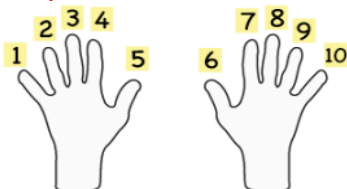
Autumn Term 1 Our theme: 'Marvellous Me'

Can you count from 1 to 10?

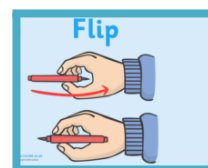

Communication and Language

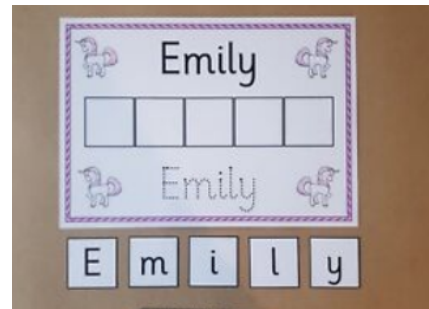
We will be focusing on sharing our ideas, listening to those of others and responding to comments made by others.

Physical Development



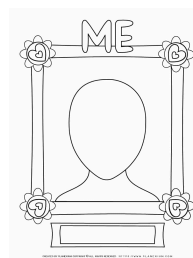
To help promote your child's independence please practise putting their coats on and zipping them up by themselves.
